What is it all about?

GSV, in partnership with Fencing Victoria, presents the 2012 GSV Fencing Skills Program. The program is open to all students from year 7-12 at GSV schools.

Over five sessions, you will discover the skills of Epée style fencing, incorporating many of the signature moves and tactics of the sport. No previous experience necessary!

Meeting Point:

Meet GSV staff on Level 1 of the Centre at least 10 minutes prior to the start of each session. A GSV staff member will be in attendance for the duration of each session and this person will assist with the administration and organisation of the program.

Cost:

\$137.50 per student (including GST)

What do I need?

- School sports uniform, runners
- Water bottle, snack (if needed)
- Any medication you may require (Ventolin/Epipen)

All protective garments and safety equipment will be provided by Fencing Victoria.

Provided by a representative from Sports Medicine Australia (SMA) and GSV staff.

The official GSV photographer (Kids Klix) will be in attendance during the final session. These will be available for purchase via the school Head of Sport in the weeks following the event.

Cancellations/Withdrawals:

Registration is confirmation of your attendance. On the date of close of entry, GSV is required to confirm numbers and staffing with the service provider (Fencing Victoria) and, as such, no refunds can be given after this date.

Minimum numbers apply for the program to proceed. Should the program be cancelled due to lack of numbers, registered participants will be notified shortly after the closing date of entries.
