What do I need?

Cancellations/Withdrawals:

A session will only be cancelled in the event of lightning/thunder or unsafe playing conditions. If this decision is made prior to the session start time, individuals will be contacted.

Registration is confirmation of your attendance. On the date of close of entry, GSV is required to confirm numbers and staffing with the service provider (Huntingdale Golf Club) and, as such, no refunds can be given after this date.

Minimum numbers apply for the program to proceed. Should the program be cancelled due to lack of numbers, registered participants will be notified shortly after the closing date of entries. A full refund will be given in this case.
